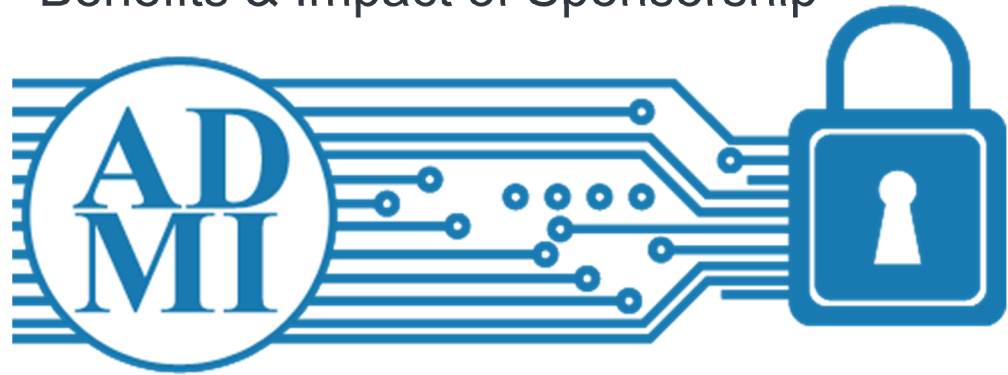

Benefits & Impact of Sponsorship



ADMI caters to some of the brightest students matriculating at Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCU). This year, ADMI is proud to be hosting the Eighth Annual HBCU Cybersecurity Competition, computing research competitions, a Computer Science Olympiad competition, and a Social Media Competition.
